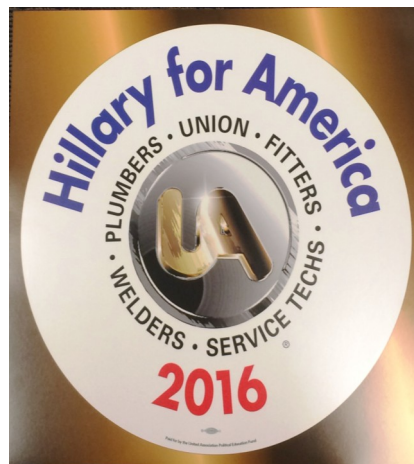

Remember to set your clocks ahead 1 hour.

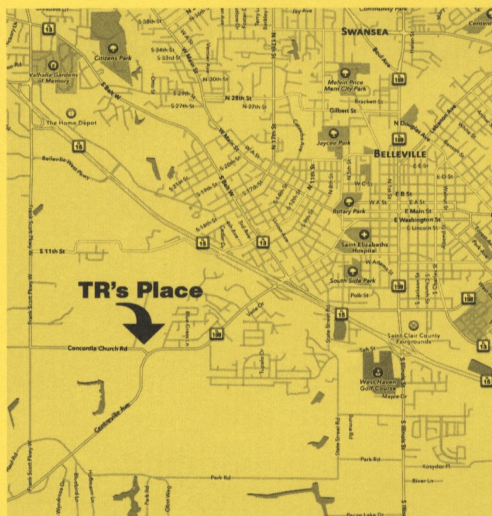
- When you have been laid off, it is your responsibility to inform the Hall. Please call to let us know your lay-off date. This includes members who have been traveling.

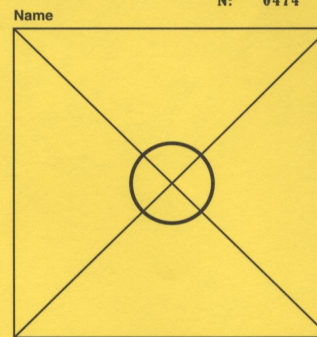
