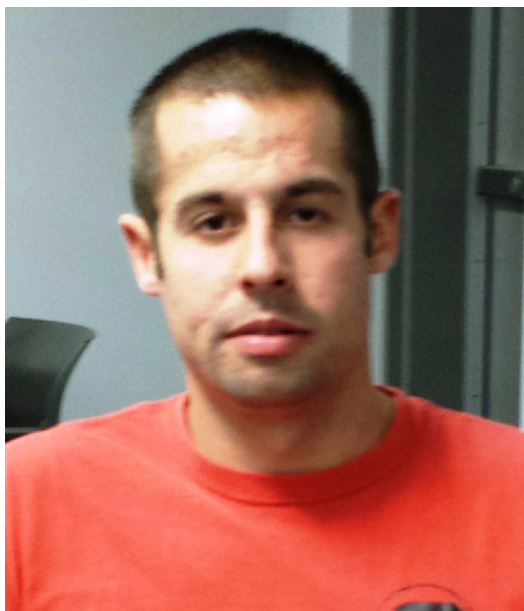

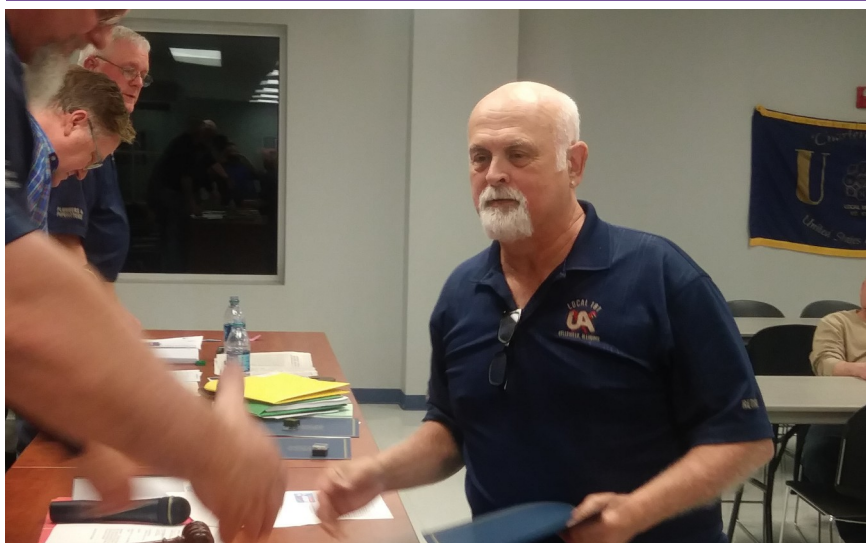

UA Scholarship Applications :

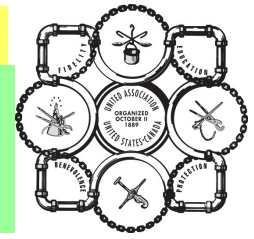
For the 2018-2019 school year are available at the Local 101 Hall, at the Union Meeting or online at uanet.org (Home page). https://uanet.org/scholarship_fund.asp You must be a full-time College/ University student. UA members, who are in good standing, and their dependents are eligible (please see criteria in the detailed instructions found with the application). Up to 112 scholarships totaling as much as \$222,000 will be awarded this year.

Applications must be postmarked by June 14, 2018.

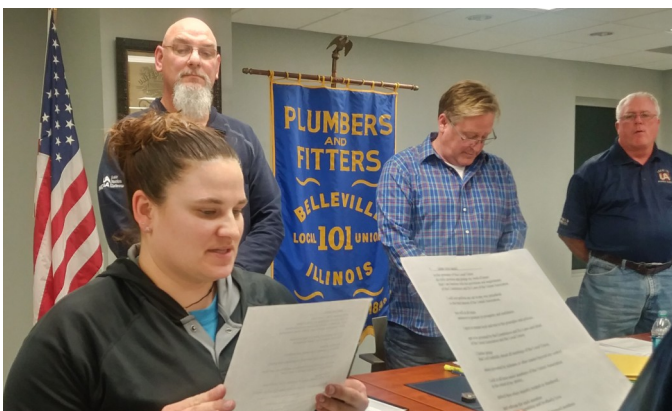
