***REMINDER to anyone who holds an OSHA 10-hour or 30-hour Card. Your OSHA certification is only valid if you have the actual card. The OSHA certifications never expire unless you do not have the actual Card. If you have taken the class within the past 36 months your Instructor can request a replacement card from OSHA. After 36 months you must retake the class to receive a new card.
